



CHESTER GETS LOST










Finally, after everyone was given a partner, Chester and his classmates climbed into the big yellow bus and were off to the park.







The path Chester took led him right to the Ranger Station. He knocked on the door, but no one was there. He looked around the side of the building and saw a pay phone.







The operator told Chester not to worry, that help was on the way. The computer at the 911 center told the dispatcher exactly where Chester was and they kept him on the phone until the police got there.




When the policeman found Chester, he was still on the phone with 911. The officer got on the phone and told the dispatcher he was with Chester and would take him back to school.




